The Department of Music at Morehouse College has had the use of new first-class pianos on a no-cost basis for the 2015-2016 academic year. This arrangement is provided through a partnership with the Rockley Family Foundation, recognized by the I.R.S. as a 501(c)(3) organization. The instruments provided to institutions and the instruments provided through other means will be sold to perpetuate this valuable program and provide scholarship money for the music students.

A large selection of grands, baby grands, digital player grands, vertical (upright) pianos, digital pianos, keyboards and orchestral strings will be available. This event will feature instruments from such famous makers as **Knabe**, **Mason & Hamlin**, **Kawai**, **Samick**, **Yamaha**, **Schimmel**, **Baldwin**, **Stravari Fine Violins**, **and other instrument manufacturers, with a discrete selection of used Steinway & Sons pianos**. Most instruments are less than one-year old, include a new factory warranty, are tuned, and ready to go. Delivery and special *no-interest financing* is available on site. Moreover, in most cases, a "substantial portion" of your purchase is considered as a charitable contribution to the Rockley Family Foundation and may be TAX DEDUCTIBLE.*

- <u>BY APPOINTMENT</u>: You are invited to attend a special "pre-sale" on Friday, March 11 and Saturday, March 12, along with our faculty and staff, prior to the general public.
