This summer the School of Music is opening a new facility for the Community School for Music and Arts in downtown Redlands to offer a wide array of music lessons to the community. Through a partnership with the Rockley Family Foundation, recognized by the I.R.S. as a 501(c)(3) organization, we will have the use of new first-class pianos and digital pianos on a no-cost basis for the 2016-2017 school year. Under this arrangement, instruments provided to other institutions and instruments otherwise made available will be sold to initiate this valuable program and to help support the Community School of Music and the Arts.

A large selection of grands, baby grands, digital player grands, vertical (upright) pianos, digital pianos, keyboards and orchestral stringed instruments will be available from such famous makers as **Steinway & Sons, Yamaha, Pramberger, Baldwin, Seiler, Knabe, Roland, Kurzweil, Stravari Fine Violins and many others**. Most instruments are less than one-year old, include a new factory warranty, and are tuned and ready to go. Delivery and special *no-interest financing* is available on-site. Moreover, in most cases, a "substantial portion" of your purchase is considered as a charitable contribution to the Rockley Family Foundation and may be TAX DEDUCTIBLE. *

There are two ways to view and purchase:

- 1) **BY APPOINTMENT:** You are invited to attend a special "private-sale" on Thursday, July 21, Friday, July 22 and the morning of Saturday, July 23 along with our faculty and staff, prior to the general public. - 2) You may attend the final sale day on *Saturday, July 23, from 2:00 6:00 P.M.* without an appointment.

This event will be held at the new Community School of Music and Arts facility at 212 E. Citrus Ave., Redlands, CA 92373 (across from the Community Bank.)
