

Pianos, Digital Pianos & Violins Available for Public Purchase Thursday, Friday & Saturday August 11-13, 2016

Dear Alumni & Friends:

The Department of Music at Collin College is hosting our FINAL piano and stringed instrument sale. The College has had the use of new pianos and digital pianos on a no-cost basis annually since 2011. This arrangement has been provided through an association with the Rockley Family Foundation, recognized by the I.R.S. as a 501(c)(3) organization. These instruments, as well as those provided to other institutions and otherwise made available will be sold to conclude our collaboration.

A large selection of grands, baby grands, digital player grands, vertical (upright) pianos, digital pianos, orchestral strings, acoustic and electric guitars will be available. This event will feature instruments from such famous makers as Yamaha, Bösendorfer, Pramberger, Seiler, Knabe, Mason & Hamlin, Stravari Fine Violins, a discrete selection of vintage Steinway & Sons pianos, and many others. Most instruments are less than one-year old, include a new factory warranty, are tuned, and ready to go. Delivery and special no-interest financing is available on site. Moreover, the Rockley Family Foundation indicates that in most cases, a substantial portion of your purchase is considered a charitable contribution to the Rockley Family Foundation and may be TAX DEDUCTIBLE. (You should consult with your own tax advisor as to the individual deductibility of any such contributions.)

There are two ways to view and purchase:

- 1) **BY APPOINTMENT:** You are invited to attend a special "private-sale" on Thursday, August 11, Friday, August 12 and the morning of Saturday, August 13, along with our faculty and staff, prior to the general public.
