The Music Department of The University of Nevada, Las Vegas will have the use of new first-class pianos on a no-cost basis for the 2017-2018 school year. This arrangement is provided through a partnership with the Rockley Family Foundation, recognized by the I.R.S. as a 501(c)(3) organization. Instruments provided to other institutions and instruments otherwise made available will be sold to initiate this valuable program and provide scholarship money for the music students.

A large selection of *grands, baby grands, digital player grands, vertical (upright) pianos, digital pianos, keyboards and orchestral strings* will be available. This event will feature instruments from such famous makers as ***Steinway & Sons, Yamaha, Seiler, Pramberger, Roland, Kurzweil, Stravari Fine Violins and many others***. Most instruments are less than one-year old, include a new factory warranty, are tuned, and ready to go. Delivery and special *no-interest financing* is available on site. Moreover, in some cases, a portion of your purchase is considered as a charitable contribution to the Rockley Family Foundation and may be TAX DEDUCTIBLE.\*

There are two ways to view and purchase:

- 1) **BY APPOINTMENT:** You are invited to attend a special “private-sale” on Thursday, April 13, Friday, April 14 and the morning of Saturday, April 15 along with our faculty and staff, prior to the general public.
