The School of Music of the University of Nebraska at Omaha had the use of new pianos and digital pianos on a no-cost basis for the 2016-2017 school year. This ongoing arrangement is provided through a partnership with the Rockley Family Foundation, recognized by the I.R.S. as a 501(c)(3) charitable organization. These instruments, instruments provided to other institutions and instruments made available by our manufacturing partners, will be sold to perpetuate this valuable program and provide financial support to the music program at UNO.

A large selection of grands, baby grands, digital player grands, vertical (upright) pianos, digital pianos, keyboards, orchestral strings will be available. This event will feature instruments from such famous makers as Steinway & Sons, Yamaha, Pramberger, Seiler, Knabe, Roland, Kurzweil, Stravari Fine Violins and many others. Most instruments are less than one-year old, include a new factory warranty, are tuned, and ready to go. Delivery and special no-interest financing is available on site. Moreover, if your purchase exceeds the Fair Market Value of the instrument, it could be considered as a charitable contribution to the Rockley Family Foundation and may be TAX DEDUCTIBLE. You should consult with your own tax adviser as to the individual deductibility of any contribution.
