A large selection of grands, baby grands, digital player grands, vertical (upright) pianos, digital pianos, keyboards & orchestral strings will be available from such famous makers as Steinway & Sons, Yamaha, Pramberger, Baldwin, Seiler, Knabe, Roland, Stravari Fine Violins and many others. Most instruments are less than one-year old, include a new factory warranty, are tuned, and ready to go. Delivery and special no-interest financing is available on site. Moreover, in most cases, a substantial portion of your purchase will be considered as a charitable contribution to the Rockley Family Foundation and may be TAX DEDUCTIBLE.*
