The Conservatory of Music and Dance of The University of Missouri-Kansas City had the use of new first-class pianos and digital pianos on a no-cost basis for the 2017-2018 school year. This ongoing arrangement is provided through a partnership with the Rockley Family Foundation, a not-for-profit organization dedicated to support music education. These instruments, and instruments made otherwise available, will be sold to perpetuate this valuable program and provide scholarship money for the music students.

A large selection of *grands, baby grands, digital player grands, vertical (upright) pianos, digital pianos, keyboards and orchestral strings* will be available. This event will feature instruments from such famous makers as *Steinway & Sons, Yamaha, Seiler, Pramberger, Roland, Stravari Fine Violins and many others*. Most instruments are less than one-year old, include a new factory warranty, are tuned, and ready to go. Delivery and special *no-interest financing* is available on site. Moreover, in most cases, a substantial portion of your purchase is considered as a charitable contribution to the Rockley Family Foundation and may be TAX DEDUCTIBLE.*

- 1) **BY APPOINTMENT:** You are invited to attend a special “private-sale” on Thursday, May 31, Friday, June 1 and the morning of Saturday, June 2, along with our faculty and staff, prior to the general public.
