The School of Music and Dance at San Diego State University has had the use of new first-class pianos and digital pianos on a no-cost basis for the 2014 school year. This arrangement is provided through a partnership with the Rockley Family Foundation, recognized by the I.R.S. as a 501(c)(3) organization. These instruments, instruments provided to other institutions, and instruments otherwise made available will be sold to perpetuate this valuable program and provide scholarship money for the music students.

A large selection of *grands, baby grands, digital player grands, vertical (upright) pianos, digital pianos, keyboards and bowed orchestral strings* will be available. This event will feature instruments from such famous makers as *Steinway & Sons, Seiler, Pramberger, Yamaha, Roland, Kurzweil, Stravari Fine Violins and many others*. Most instruments are less than one-year old, include a new factory warranty, are tuned, and ready to go. Delivery and special *no-interest financing* is available on site. Moreover, in most cases, a “substantial portion” of your purchase is considered as a charitable contribution to the Rockley Family Foundation and may be TAX DEDUCTIBLE.*


There are two ways to view and purchase:
