The Department of Music at Metropolitan State University of Denver had the use of new first-class pianos on a no-cost basis for the 2015-2016 school year. This arrangement is provided through a partnership with the Rockley Family Foundation, recognized by the I.R.S. as a 501(c)(3) organization. These instruments, instruments provided to other institutions and instruments made available by our manufacturing partners will be sold to perpetuate this valuable program and provide scholarship money for the music students.

A large selection of *grands, baby grands, digital player grands, vertical (upright) pianos, digital pianos, keyboards & orchestral strings* will be available from such famous makers as ***Steinway & Sons, Yamaha, Pramberger, Baldwin, Seiler, Knabe, Roland, Kurzweil, Stravari Fine Violins and many others.*** Most instruments are less than one-year old, include a new factory warranty, are tuned, and ready to go. Delivery and special *no-interest financing* is available on site. Moreover, in most cases, a “substantial portion” of your purchase will be considered as a charitable contribution to the Rockley Family Foundation and may be TAX DEDUCTIBLE.*

- 1) **BY APPOINTMENT:** You are invited to attend a special “pre sale” on Friday, April 22 and Saturday, April 23, along with our faculty and staff, prior to the general public.
