Thursday, Friday & Saturday, July 20-22, 2017**

Dear Alumni & Friends:

Last summer the School of Music opened a new facility for the Community School for Music and Arts in downtown Redlands to offer a wide array of music lessons to the community. Through a partnership with the Rockley Family Foundation, recognized by the I.R.S. as a 501(c)(3) organization, we have had the use of new first-class pianos and digital pianos on a no-cost basis for the 2016-2017 school year. Under this arrangement, these instruments (along with instruments provided to other institutions and instruments otherwise made available) will be sold to perpetuate this valuable program and to help support the Community School of Music and the Arts.

A large selection of *grands, baby grands, digital player grands, vertical (upright) pianos, digital pianos, keyboards and orchestral stringed instruments* will be available from such famous makers as **Steinway & Sons, Yamaha, Pramberger, Baldwin, Seiler, Knabe, Roland, Kurzweil, Stravari Fine Violins and many others**. Most instruments are less than one-year old, include a new factory warranty, and are tuned and ready to go. Delivery and special *no-interest financing* is available on-site. Moreover, in most cases, a “substantial portion” of your purchase is considered as a charitable contribution to the Rockley Family Foundation and may be TAX DEDUCTIBLE. *

There are two ways to view and purchase:

- 1) **BY APPOINTMENT:** You are invited to attend a special “private-sale” on Thursday, July 20, Friday, July 21 and the morning of Saturday, July 22 along with our faculty and staff, prior to the general public. This appointment will give you an opportunity to purchase with priority in selection and price reductions. To secure a time call: **(909) 307-7617**.
- 2) You may attend the final sale day on *Saturday, July 22, from 2:00 - 5:00 P.M.* without an appointment.
