Instruments provided to other institutions and instruments otherwise made available, will be sold to support this program and provide funding for our student teachers.

This event will feature instruments from such famous makers as Knabe, Baldwin, Mason & Hamlin, Kawai, Samick, Yamaha, Schimmel, Kohler & Campbell, Hallet Davis, Stravari Fine Violins, and other instrument manufacturers, with a discrete selection of used Steinway & Sons pianos. Most instruments are less than one year old, include a new factory warranty, are tuned, and ready to go. Delivery and technical services are provided by Cooper Piano Company and special no-interest financing is available on-site.
