This event will feature instruments from such famous makers as Yamaha, Bösendorfer, Pramberger, Seiler, Knabe, Mason & Hamlin, a discrete selection of vintage Steinway & Sons pianos, and many others. Most instruments are less than one-year old, include a new factory warranty, are tuned, and ready to go. Delivery and special no-interest financing is available on site. Moreover, in most cases, a substantial portion of your purchase can be considered as a charitable contribution to the Rockley Family Foundation and may be TAX DEDUCTIBLE.*

There are two ways to view and purchase:

- 1. BY APPOINTMENT:** You are invited to attend a special "private-sale" on Thursday, October 26, Friday, October 27 and the morning of Saturday, October 28, prior to the general public.
