This ongoing arrangement is provided through a partnership with the Rockley Family Foundation, recognized by the I.R.S. as a 501(c)(3) organization.* These instruments, instruments provided to other institutions and instruments made available by our manufacturing partners will be sold to perpetuate this valuable program and provide scholarship money for the music students.


A selection of *grands, baby grands, digital player grands, vertical (upright) pianos, digital pianos, keyboards and bowed stringed instruments* will be available from such famous makers as ***Pramberger, Seiler, Knabe, Yamaha, Roland, Kurzweil, Stravari Fine Violins, with a discrete selection of used Steinway & Sons, and many others.*** Most instruments are less than one-year old, include a new factory warranty, are tuned, and ready to go. Delivery and special *no-interest financing* is available on site.

There are two ways to view and purchase:

- 1) **BY APPOINTMENT:** You are invited to attend a special “pre-sale” on Thursday, January 25, Friday, January 26 and the morning of Saturday, January 27, along with our faculty and staff, prior to the general public. - 2) You may attend the final sale day on *Saturday, January 27, from 2:00 PM - 5:00 PM* without an appointment.
