

## Pianos, Digital Pianos, and Violins Available for Public Purchase Thursday, Friday, & Saturday, January 10-12, 2019

Dear Alumni & Friends:

The School of Music and Dance at San Diego State University has had the use of new first-class pianos and digital pianos on a no-cost basis since 2014. This arrangement has been provided through a partnership with the Rockley Family Foundation, a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization. These instruments, as well as those provided to other institutions, or otherwise made available will be sold to complete this valuable program and provide scholarship money for music students at SDSU.

A large selection of grand pianos, baby grands, digital player grands, vertical (upright) pianos, digital pianos, keyboards, violins, violas, cellos and basses will be available. This event will feature instruments from such famous makers as **Steinway & Sons, Seiler, Yamaha, Roland, Stravari Fine Violins and many others**. Most instruments are less than one-year old, include a new factory warranty, are tuned, and ready to go. Delivery and special *no-interest financing* is available on-site. Moreover, in most cases, a substantial portion of your purchase is considered as a charitable contribution to the Rockley Family Foundation and may be **tax deductible**.\*

There are two ways to view and purchase the instruments:

- By Appointment: You are invited to attend a special "pre-sale" on Thursday, January 10; Friday, January 11; and the morning of Saturday, January 12, along with our faculty and staff, prior to the general public. This will give you an opportunity to purchase with priority in selection and price reductions. To secure a time call: (619) 594-5369
