A selection of grands, baby grands, digital player grands, vertical (upright) pianos, digital pianos, and orchestral (bowed) string instruments, will be available from such renowned builders as Seiler, Yamaha, Roland, Stravari Fine Violins, with a discrete selection of used Steinway & Sons pianos, and many others.

Most instruments are less than one-year old, include a new factory warranty. They are tuned, and ready to go. Delivery and special *no-interest financing* is available on site. There are two ways to view and purchase:

- 1) **BY APPOINTMENT:** You are invited to join our faculty and staff a special "pre-sale" on Thursday, January 31, Friday, February 1 and the morning of Saturday, February 2.
