The University of Delaware has had the use of new first-class pianos on a no-cost basis for the 2018 year. This ongoing arrangement is provided through a partnership with the Rockley Family Foundation, recognized by the I.R.S. as a 501(c)(3) organization.* These instruments, as well as those provided to other institutions or otherwise made available will be sold to perpetuate this valuable program.

A selection of grands, baby grands, digital player grands, vertical (upright) pianos, digital pianos, keyboards and bowed stringed instruments will be available from such famous makers as *Seiler, Yamaha, Roland, Stravari Fine Violins, with a discrete selection of used Steinway & Sons and many others*. Most instruments are less than one-year old, include a new factory warranty, are tuned, and ready to go. Delivery and special no-interest financing is available on site.

There are two ways to view and purchase:

- 1) <u>BY APPOINTMENT</u>: You are invited to attend a special "pre-sale" on Thursday, January 24, Friday, January 25, and the morning of Saturday, January 26 along with our faculty and staff prior to the general public.
