This arrangement is provided through a partnership with the Rockley Family Foundation, a non-profit organization dedicated to supporting music education. The instruments provided to institutions or otherwise made available will be sold to initiate this valuable program, provide resources to the department and scholarship money for the music students.

A large selection of *grands, baby grands, digital player grands, vertical (upright) pianos, digital pianos, violins, violas and cellos* will be available. This event will feature instruments from such famous makers as ***Yamaha, Bösendorfer, Cristofori, Roland, Stravari Fine Violins, and other instrument manufacturers, with a discrete selection of vintage Steinway & Sons pianos.*** Most instruments are less than one-year old, include a new factory warranty, are tuned, and ready to go. Delivery and special no-interest financing is available on site. Moreover, in most cases, a substantial portion of your purchase is considered as a charitable contribution to the Rockley Family Foundation and may be TAX DEDUCTIBLE.\*
