This arrangement is provided through a partnership with the Rockley Family Foundation, a not for profit organization dedicated to help support music education. These instruments and instruments made otherwise available will be sold to perpetuate this valuable program and provide scholarship money for the music students.

A large selection of grands, baby grands, digital player grands, vertical (upright) pianos, digital pianos, keyboards, violins, violas, cellos and basses will be available from such famous makers as Steinway & Sons, Yamaha, Pramberger, Seiler, Roland, Stravari Fine Violins and many others. Most instruments are less than one-year old, include a new factory warranty, are tuned, and ready to go. Delivery and special no-interest financing is available on site. Moreover, in most cases, a substantial portion of your purchase will be considered as a charitable contribution to the Rockley Family Foundation and may be TAX DEDUCTIBLE.\*
