This ongoing arrangement is provided through a partnership with the Rockley Family Foundation, recognized by the I.R.S. as a 501(c)(3) organization.* These instruments, instruments provided to other institutions and instruments made otherwise available, will be sold to perpetuate this valuable program.

A selection of grands, baby grands, digital player grands, vertical (upright) pianos and digital pianos, will be available from such famous makers as Seiler, Pramberger, Yamaha, Roland, with a discrete selection of used Steinway & Sons pianos, and many others. Most instruments are less than one-year old, include a new factory warranty, are tuned, and ready to go. Delivery and special no-interest financing is available on site.

- BY APPOINTMENT: You are invited to attend a special "pre-sale" on Thursday, May 16, Friday, May 17 and the morning of Saturday, May 18, along with our faculty and staff, prior to admission of the general public.
