A large selection of *grand pianos*, *baby grands*, *digital player grands*, *vertical (upright) pianos*, *and digital pianos* will be available. This event will feature instruments from such famous makers as *Kawai*, *Shigeru Kawai*, *a selection of vintage Steinway & Sons*, *Yamaha and many others*. Most instruments are less than one year old, include a new factory warranty, are tuned, and ready to go. Delivery and technical services are provided by Maus Piano. Special *no-interest financing* is available on site. Moreover, in most cases, a "substantial portion" of your purchase is considered as a charitable contribution to the Rockley Family Foundation and may be TAX DEDUCTIBLE.*
