The School of Music of the University of Nebraska at Omaha is hosting our FINAL piano and stringed instrument sale with the Rockley Family Foundation. The College of Music has had the use of new first-class pianos and digital pianos on a no-cost basis donated annually since 2009. This arrangement has been provided through a partnership with the Rockley Family Foundation, recognized by the I.R.S. as a 501(c)(3) organization. These instruments, along with others previously owned by private parties and other institutions, will be sold to conclude our collaboration.

A large selection of grands, baby grands, digital player grands, vertical (upright) pianos, digital pianos, keyboards, orchestral strings will be available. This event will feature instruments from such famous makers as *Steinway & Sons, Yamaha, Pramberger, Seiler, Knabe, Roland, Stravari Fine Violins and many others*. Most instruments are less than one-year old, include a new factory warranty, significantly discounted from brand new retail price, are tuned, and ready to go. Delivery and special *no-interest financing* is available on site. Moreover, if your purchase exceeds the Fair Market Value of the instrument, it could be considered as a charitable contribution to the Rockley Family Foundation and may be TAX DEDUCTIBLE. You should consult with your own tax adviser as to the individual deductibility of any contribution.
