The Music Program of Raritan Valley Community College has had the use of new first-class pianos on a no cost basis for the 2018-2019 year. This ongoing arrangement is provided through a partnership with the Rockley Family Foundation, recognized by the I.R.S. as a 501(c)(3) organization.\* These instruments, as well as ones made otherwise available will be sold to perpetuate this valuable program and provide support for the Music Program.

A selection of *grands, baby grands, digital player grands, vertical (upright) pianos, digital pianos, violins, violas and cellos* will be available from such famous makers as ***Pramberger, Seiler, Yamaha, Roland, Stravari Fine Violins with a discrete selection of used Steinway & Sons pianos, and many others.*** Most instruments are less than one-year old, include a new factory warranty, are tuned, and ready to go. Delivery and special *no-interest financing* is available on site.

There are two ways to view and purchase:

- 1) **BY APPOINTMENT:** You are invited to attend a special “pre-sale” on Thursday, August 22, Friday, August 23 and the morning of Saturday, August 24, along with our faculty and staff, prior to admission of the general public.
