This sale will feature a large selection of grands, baby grands, digital player grands, vertical (upright) pianos, digital pianos, keyboards, and orchestral stringed instruments from famous makers such as **Steinway & Sons**, **Yamaha, Pramberger, Seiler, Roland, Stravari Fine Violins, and many others.** Most instruments are less than one-year old, include a new factory warranty, and are tuned and ready to play. Delivery and special no-interest financing is available on-site. In most cases, a substantial portion of your purchase will be considered as a charitable contribution to the Rockley Family Foundation and may be tax deductible.*

- You are invited to attend a special private sale by appointment on Thursday, August 15, Friday, August 16, and the morning of Saturday, August 17, along with our faculty and staff, prior to the general public.
