The University of Colorado Colorado Springs has had the use of new first-class pianos and digital pianos on a no-cost basis for the 2018-2019 school year. This arrangement is provided through a partnership with the Rockley Family Foundation, recognized by the I.R.S. as a 501(c)(3) organization. These instruments, instruments provided to other institutions and ones otherwise made available, will be sold to perpetuate this valuable program and provide scholarship money for the music students.

A large selection of grands, baby grands, digital player grands, vertical (upright) pianos, digital pianos, violins, violas, cellos and basses will be available. This event will feature instruments from such famous makers as **Steinway & Sons, Yamaha, Pramberger, Seiler, Roland, Stravari Fine Violins and many others**. Most instruments are less than one-year old, include a new factory warranty, are tuned, and ready to go. Delivery and special *no-interest financing* is available on site. Moreover, in most cases, a "substantial portion" of your purchase is considered as a charitable contribution to the Rockley Family Foundation and may be TAX DEDUCTIBLE.*
